

Syntax – Sentence Structure Examples

<p>3-Action Sentence (Parallel Structure)</p>	<p>The mouse scampered across the floor, hid under the refrigerator, and squeaked when the cat appeared.</p>
<p>Several Action Expanders in One Sentence</p>	<p>When the sun rays warmed the beach, many sun bathers waded into the ocean to cool off, although the waves were very rough.</p>
<p>Rename (Appositive)</p>	<p>My English teacher, Mrs. Shires, shows me the fun of syntax.</p>
<p>-ing</p>	<p>The dog barked, awakening everyone in the neighborhood.</p>
<p>Noun, Part, +-ing</p>	<p>The boy slipped and fell, his ankle twisting painfully.</p>
<p>Describer Group (adjective)</p>	<p>The students left the room, joyous about their grades.</p>
<p>Double Describer (adjectives set in apposition)</p>	<p>The monster, cruel and determined, stalked its prey.</p>
